By the Lord's grace, after many struggles, we were able to send 58 boxes of evangelistic materials (tracts, New Testaments, and John and Romans) to Ecuador. In a similar fashion my wife and I were able to go to Ecuador and visit various cities there. We spent a time of fellowship with the Guayllabamba Baptist Church in which we were able to share the Scriptures with brethren of that church and various missions around the capitol of the country, the city of Quito.

We were also able to travel in the Andes mountains visiting other provinces where we hope to send a second shipment of materials.

Our goal is to disseminate sound doctrine in the most needy areas of the country.

We thank God that now Missionary Michael Lea, from our church, has arrived to help in Ecuador.



Another blessing we have had lately was to participate with the brethren of Chiapas, Mexico, in the 50 year celebration of the ministry of Bro. Milton Martin, who is a real example of service to the Lord.

I took advantage of the opportunity to learn more about the work there and to visit some churches in the area and share with them.

I learned a phrase from Bro. Milton that inspires me every day in my missionary work; "God does not give impossible commands."



Upon returning to Panama, we have continued with the radio programs and discipleship.

We held our Conference 2014 in the El Camino Baptist Church with the participation of Panamanian churches and the visit of Pastor Luis Tulcanaza of Ecuador who was one of the speakers.

We are placing special emphasis in these last few months on training those who are called to serve in different places, primarily in the Indian and country areas, which have less access to study materials and regular training.

We developed a plan of having training seminars for three days each month with the brethren from the most distant areas in which we will provide them with study materials that will help them grow spiritually. We are also working to strengthen the Bible correspondence course students in those areas.

September 6th I will travel to the area of Llano Ñopo in the Indian area to meet with people who study the correspondence courses and listen to the radio program.

Please pray for the conference we will hold September 19th and 20th in Peñon, in the Buglere region of the Indian area. We are getting printed materials ready to give to those who will be participating.

September is officially the month of the Bible in Panama, and there are many activities related to that theme, and open doors to distribute a lot of literature in the country.

In our small print shop we have about 10,000 Bible study booklets, tracts and other literature that will be distributed during this time in the areas that are most needful of the biblical message.

Please pray for the souls that will receive these materials; that their hearts would be open to the message of salvation by faith in Jesus Christ, and likewise that the Lord would give us the resources that we need to fulfill this mission in five provinces of

My family continues to be a big help in the ministry. Our oldest daughter, Dayanis, is serving full time as secretary in the office where we produce the materials. My wife and our other children are involved in other aspects of the work.

For the last two months I have been helping the El Camino Baptist Church in an interim capacity in a difficult stage they are going through.
